
#### **OPEN DAY**

# **Upcoming CCTV installation on the Estate**

### We are enhancing security on the estate!

Over the next few weeks, Dezine Host will be installing CCTV cameras in key areas to ensure a safer and more secure environment for everyone. As agreed, the cameras will be placed at strategic locations, including the ground floor/entrance hall, outside by the bin shed, both garden areas and at the main entrance.

We appreciate your cooperation and look forward to the benefits this upgrade will bring to the community.
