Greening Waterloo

The Waterloo Quarter Business Improvement District (BID) are planning a planting scheme in Waterloo over the summer. This planting project is intended to make the street scene more attractive and promote a greener Waterloo with sustainable urban drainage.

Planters will be owned and maintained by the BID, however if residents from Styles House wish to get involved in either the planting, or watering of them they would be most welcome.

Consultation

Styles House residents consulted so far have responded positively to the planting plans on The Cut providing seating is not installed as it could lead to nuisance issues.

Location

One of the proposed chosen locations is The Cut outside Styles House near the junction with Hatfields. Both Southwark and Lambeth Councils have agreed in principle to The Cut which has been identified as having high numbers of pedestrians and the highest possible impact visually. The idea is to reuse old oil cans - full sized and cut into halves then painted to make them more appealing.

Planting

The Waterloo Quarter BID will arrange to have the cans planted by interested members of the community through a planting event in the summer. Planters will be owned and maintained by the BID, however if residents from Styles House wish to get involved in either the planting, or watering of them they would be most welcome! Residents consulted so far have responded positively to the planting plans on The Cut providing seating is not provided as it could lead to nuisance issues.

BBQs

BBQs are not permitted on the balconies – under the terms of your tenancy. The TMO do have some large BBQs for resident use. Please contact a Board member or Richard at the TMO office if you want to use one and remember to give reasonable advance notice. You will be expected to clean the BBQ

- Southwark still is responsible for work to heating, hot water, the lifts and garages.

Recycling disposal of unwanted furniture

White Plastic Recycling Bags

The white recycling bags should be put outside your door on Tuesday night for a Wednesday morning collection. Please do not put your bags out by the bins because they will not be collected.

Bulky Rubbish & Unwanted Large Items

Over the last few weeks you may have seen furniture items left near the refuse bins. The council no longer collects such items unless the correct procedure is followed. Fortunately it is **simple** and **free**:

Either:

Call Environmental Services helpline on: **0207 525 2000**, on answering you will be given options to reach the correct department - in this case **press 2** - to inform them what you want removing. List everything, because they will only take what is on the list.

Or:

Contact them via the Southwark Council website www.southwark.gov.uk where you will be directed to Environmental Services.

You will be given a **reference number** and a **collection date** and told **when** you can put your items outside by the bins.

The council is now investigating any unauthorised dumping.

Large Recycling Items

The large recycling bin by the bins is for items that won't fit into your white plastic recycling bags. Please fold up all cardboard boxes otherwise it gets full pretty quickly. The TMO welcomes any suggestions for improving and increasing recycling.
