

TMO goes live!

The story so far...

Styles TMO went live on 6th January 2014. A launch event was held attended by residents, Simon Hughes MP, Gerri Scott, Director of Housing and Cllr. Ian Wingfield.



This means that the TMO is now responsible for:

- Some repairs
- Managing lower level rent arrears
- First point of contact for housing concerns

Most routine or non-emergency repairs should now be report to the TMO who will send around your Caretaker to inspect and where possible carry out the repairs.

You can report repairs to the Office, via the Caretaker or by phone or e mail.

It also means that from now on if your rent account falls into arrears it will be the TMO who will contact you, arrange meetings and issue any letters on behalf of Southwark

If you have any problems including rent issues you can come to the TMO office for Drop in sessions or book an appointment.

One of the main aims of setting up the TMO was to give you a more personalised service. Lately you will have seen two new faces on the estate:

EMERGENCIES

Completed within 24 hours or If dangerous, within 4 hours. E.g faults that are a risk to your health or could damage your home such as:

- No electricity in your home
- No lighting in your home
- Serious plumbing leaks
- Securing property after a break-in
- Blocked toilet

Out of hours i.e. between 5pm and 9am contact

URGENT REPAIRS

Completed within 3 working days e.g. repairs that we don't consider an emergency but we still consider urgent such as:

- Loss of some electric power
- Loss of water supply
- No heating or hot-water
- Blocked sink

ROUTINE REPAIRS

Completed within 30 working days. These are the most common type of repair. These are repairs that do not cause a risk to your health or extensive damage to your home such as a dripping tap or damaged to plaster.

The TMO has employed a caretaker to help carry out repairs to tenant's homes, communal area and outside the blocks.

- We want the TMO to carry out as many small repairs as possible.
- For larger repairs we are working with Leathermarket another resident led housing company
- Southwark still is responsible for work to heating, hot water, the lifts and garages.

Recycling disposal of unwanted furniture

White Plastic Recycling Bags

The white recycling bags should be put outside your door on Tuesday night for a Wednesday morning collection. Please do not put your bags out by the bins because they will not be collected.

Bulky Rubbish & Unwanted Large Items

Over the last few weeks you may have seen furniture items left near the refuse bins. The council no longer collects such items unless the correct procedure is followed. Fortunately it is **simple** and **free**:

Either:

Call Environmental Services helpline on: **0207 525 2000**, on answering you will be given options to reach the correct department - in this case **press 2** - to inform them what you want removing. List everything, because they will only take what is on the list.

Or:

Contact them via the Southwark Council website www.southwark.gov.uk where you will be directed to Environmental Services.

You will be given a **reference number** and a **collection date** and told **when** you can put your items outside by the bins.

The council is now investigating any unauthorised dumping.

Large Recycling Items

The large recycling bin by the bins is for items that won't fit into your white plastic recycling bags. Please fold up all cardboard boxes otherwise it gets full pretty quickly. The TMO welcomes any suggestions for improving and increasing recycling.
